Mr. Benjamin Gentry, a young farmer who resides near Parker's Grove, died at the St. Luke Hospital in Hodgenville last Saturday afternoon at 1 o'clock after 10 days illness of typhoid fever. He had been brought here about 3 weeks ago to undergo an operation, which operation had proven quite successful, and he was making preparations to go to his home when typhoid fever developed. ?????? hands and skilled attendants could provide, but it could easily be detected 2 or 3 days before the final summons came that his condition was serious. Trained nurses assisted in taking care of him. On Saturday afternoon the remains were taken to the home of the young man's father, Mr. William Gentry, where they remained until Sunday afternoon at 2:30 o'clock, when they were taken to the South Fork church, which church the deceased was a member of and had always been a conscientious worker, where the funeral services were conducted by the pastor, Rev. H. S. Bell, of Buffalo. There was the largest crowd in attendance at this funeral that ever was known to attend one at this house of worship. Interment followed in South Fork Cemetery. Mr. Gentry was a man of exceptionally good moral habits and one that enjoyed the friendship of all that knew him.

On May 6, 1909, the Angel of Death entered the home of Mr. R. W. Hayes and took from him his dear devoted wife who died of the dreadful disease, consumption. 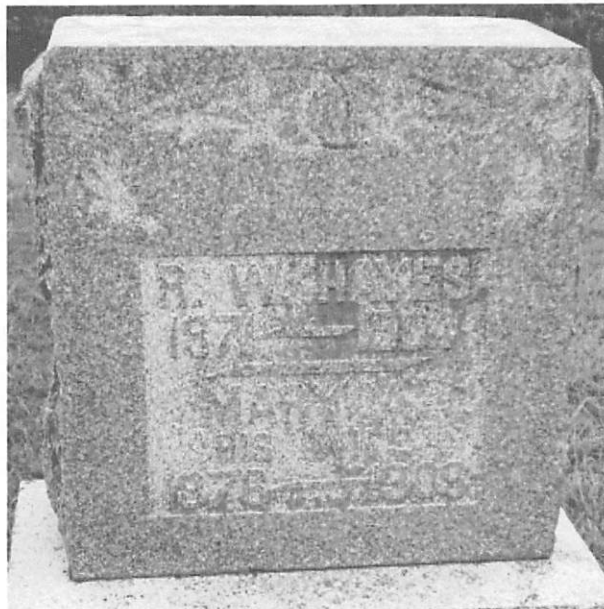
