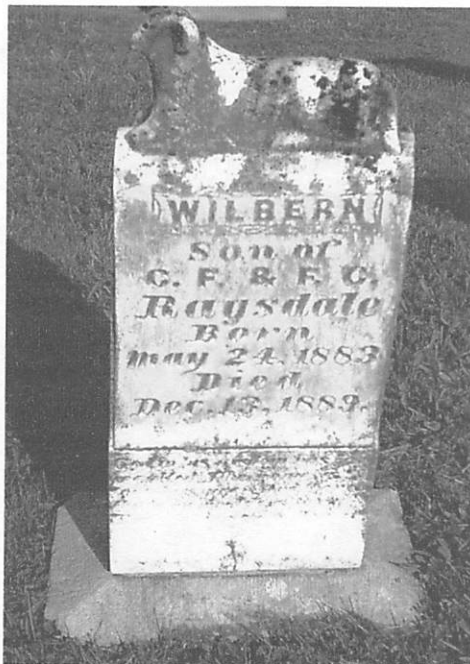

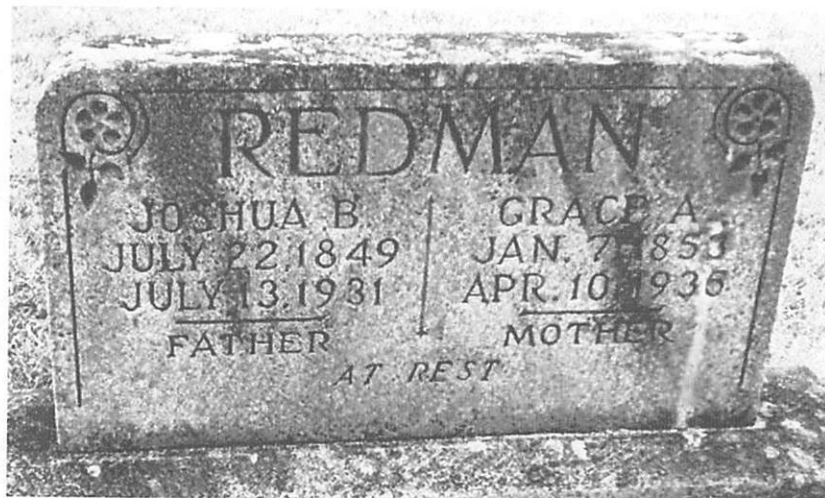

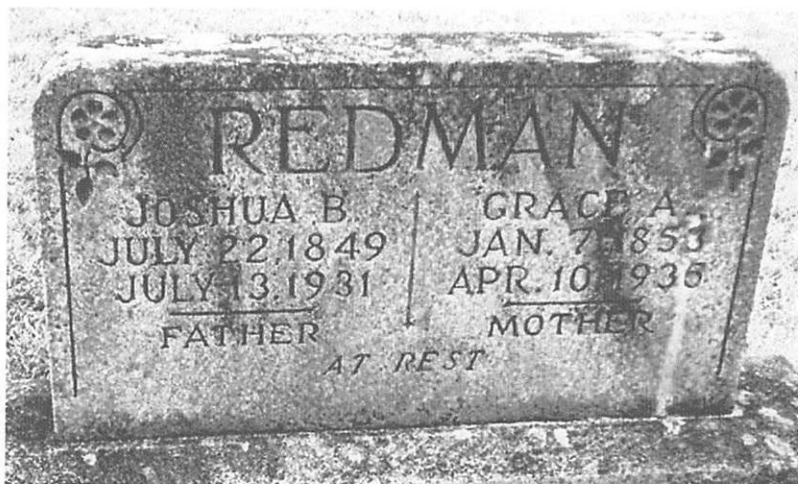

Joshua Redman, who would have been 82 years of age on the 22nd of this month, died at his home near Elizabethtown on July 13th, a son of the late Richard and Margaret Bayne Redman. He was the last of 13 children. On Saturday before his death, while attempting to draw a bucket of water, he fell in a well. A ten year old grandson hearing his cries for help, climbed down in the well, his grandfather told him that he was too small to assist him, and sent the boy to a field for his father, Owen Walters, who came and got Mr. Redman out just as he became so exhausted that he had lost his hold on the wall and was sinking in the water. He died from internal injuries received in the fall. He is survived by his wife, Mrs. Grace Thomas Redman, and 3 daughters, Mrs. Harvey Elliott, of Kosmosdale; Mrs. Owen Walters, and Mrs. V. H. Tabb of Elizabethtown, and 2 sons, Herman Redman of Louisville, and Elmer Redman of Elizabethtown. Mr. Redman had spent almost his entire life in this county, removing to Hardin County about 18 years ago. Burial in South Fork Cemetery.

The death of Mr. Jacob Sallee has caused universal sorrow and regret in all this section. But few men were as highly esteemed, and his place as a citizen, church member and kind neighbor will be hard to fill. The funeral services took place at South Fork Church on the day following his death, and was attended by a crowded house of warm and sympathizing friends and relatives. This disclosure was delivered by the pastor, Rev. W. J. Puckett, selecting for the solemn occasion the following appropriate scripture: "Blessed are the dead which die in the Lord from henceforth: Yea, saith the Spirit, that they may rest from their labors; and their works do follow them". Rev. xiv: 13. After the services the remains were laid to rest in the pretty cemetery near the church. The following well-selected, warmly admiring friends, served as pall-bearers: John W. Read and G. L. Hamilton of Hodgenville, J. S. Mather and W. B. Daugherty of Silva, H. M. Thomas and H. W. Ramsey of this place. Mr. Sallee confessed and obeyed the Savior in the year 1866 and united with South Fork Baptist Church, of which he was one of the pillars and most devoted members until the Lord called him home. The deceased was born December 2, 1832 and would have been 67 his next birthday. Besides the devoted wife and loving daughter, Mrs. Katie Mather, wife of Logan Mather, there are left to mourn their invaluable loss, two sisters and three brothers: Mrs. Cynthia Allen, Mrs. M. E. Clayton and Mr. Murdock Sallee of Arkansas, Mr. G. W. Sallee of Nolin and J. E. Sallee of this place. Tommie, the little son, preceded the father in death several years past: and so great was the love and devotion of the father for his promising little boy that he never entirely recovered from the shock caused by his untimely death. In addition to his many other virtues, there was no man in the county of whom the people entertained a higher

degree of confidence than they did in Mr. Sallee. In the year 1887 he was elected and served as a member of the Lower House of Kentucky Legislature. His services reflected great credit upon himself and gave general satisfaction to the people. No one ever called into question his perfect honesty in all his acts and the deep welfare he had for his constituents; and while firm in all his opinions he was nevertheless unobtrusive, never giving offense to anyone. It seems strange to us that such a useful and honorable one as Mr. Sallee should be removed from us, but God's ways are not our ways; and we would say to the sorrowing ones that while this is a sad hour to them, some "sweet day" all will be well; joy will dispel all sorrow. The departed one is free from all earthly ills and sorrows, and has crossed the great chasm of death and gone to join the great army of the redeemed of God, where he will lift his voice in melodious strains unknown to earth, and hear the welcomed voices of ones over there, where--Life shall be Lord of Death--And love shall never lose it's own.
