Mr. Spratt had been twice married, his first wife being Miss Ida Poteet, and after her death he was married to Miss Vanda Hudgins, who has also been dead for a number of years. Eight children by the first marriage survive, Messrs. Glover and Hubert Spratt, of this county; Mrs. Omer McCubbin, of near here; Mrs. Richard Twyman of Louisville; Mrs. Dan Bynum, and Mrs. Dudley Welch; and Misses Grace and Lois Spratt of Artesia. One daughter by the second marriage, Miss Beatrice Spratt, of Buffalo, also survives. The body was brought here for burial in the family burial plat in South Fork Cemetery. A few weeks ago Mr. Spratt made a business trip to Kentucky, and it is said that on his return to New Mexico, he began to fail rapidly, death resulting after a 4 days critical illness. 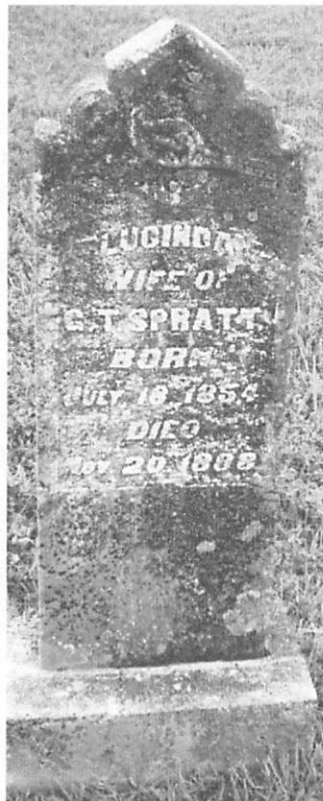
